## Scene 4: Bethlehem

Child 2	They've all gone. What shall we do now?
	TRAVELLERS 10 and 11 re-enter and start to walk across the stage. They see the CHILDREN.
Traveller 10	Are you children still by yourselves? Where are your parents now?
Child 1	Er, they've just gone to look for somewhere to stay.
Child 2	They told us to wait here. They'll be back soon.
Traveller 11	Well, good luck to them. Because of the census, the town is full of visitors. You'll be lucky to find a floor to sleep on.
Child 3	What's a census?
Traveller 10	Surely you know? It means that all the people have to be counted.
Child 1	(quietly, to CHILD 3) It's like taking the register at school.
Traveller 11	We've been looking for Mary and Joseph. Have you seen them?
	The CHILDREN shake their heads.
Traveller 11	They probably arrived hours ago. They'd travel more quickly with a donkey. I bet they're in bed, asleep by now. Just as we should be!
Traveller 10	Goodbye. We'll no doubt see you on the return journey!
	The CHILDREN wave as the TRAVELLERS exit.
Child 2	But where are Joseph and Mary? I didn't see them on the journey.
Child 3	(looks off-stage) Look they're coming now.
	MARY and JOSEPH enter.
Mary	Oh, Joseph, we're very late arriving. So many people passed us on the way but the road was stony and I was scared to travel any faster.
Joseph	Yes, I was worried that the donkey might stumble. Anyway, we're here now. Let's knock on a door and ask for shelter.
	The CHILDREN turn another page in the book and the three INNKEEPERS enter, each holding a 'window'.
